Australia's best beef and lamb titles at steak tomorrow

Tomorrow we'll be saying 'well done' to Australia's best steak and lamb, when they're crowned at the Royal Queensland Food and Wine Show (RQFWS) Branded Beef and Lamb Competition presented by Super Butcher at the Brisbane Showgrounds.

It follows a two day judging process this week which saw 14 of Queensland's top judges and food experts, including Chief Judge Elaine Millar and Wild Canary Executive Chef Glen Barratt, taste their way through 70 of the nation's finest beef and lamb products in the retail market.

The Branded Beef and Lamb Competition is regarded as the most coveted and comprehensive of its kind in the nation, with entries slightly up this year.

The entries cover eight classes including grain fed, grass fed, Wagyu (marble score of 1-5), Wagyu (marble score of 6+), branded lamb 20kg or less, branded lamb more than 20kg and the new class restaurant trade branded lamb more than 24kg.

The prestigious RQFWS is dedicated to celebrating the nation's finest produce and continues to unearth Australia's top food and wine products year after year.

The award-winning beef and lamb products will be served at the fine dining steakhouse restaurant at the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka), which is now just 99 days away.
